IEC 60794-1-1:2023 provides a generic specification for optical fiber cables, covering geometrical, transmission, material, mechanical, ageing, climatic, and electrical properties. It serves as the reference for all other IEC 60794-x series standards and is widely used for communication equipment and hybrid cables, ensuring uniformity across manufacturers and applications. ITU-T G.65x series defines optical fiber types and subcategories, including single-mode and multimode fibers, with specifications for attenuation, chromatic dispersion, cut-off wavelengths, and macro-bending losses. Subcategories like G.652, G.655, and G.657 are widely used for backbone, DWDM, and FTTH networks. ANSI/TIA-568.3-E focuses on premises optical fiber cabling, specifying performance, transmission, and test requirements for cables, connectors, and patch cords. It includes polarity methods for duplex and array connectivity, ensuring interoperability in enterprise and data center environments.

- Fiber type: Single-mode (SMF) or multimode (MMF)
