Tray cables use color-coded conductors to identify their function and maintain compliance with the NEC. Common color conventions include:

- Black, Red, Blue: Typically used for phase or hot conductors in three-phase systems .
- White: Reserved for the neutral conductor .
- Green: Designated for grounding .
- Orange, Yellow, Brown: Often used as additional phase conductors or for multi-conductor cables where more than three phases are present .

- Tracer Colors: When more conductors are added, a tracer color is applied to distinguish conductors without duplicating the base color .

Outdoor and Sunlight-Resistant Tray Cables

For exposed installations, black or dark jackets are preferred because they contain carbon black, which blocks UV radiation . Cables marked “Sunlight Resistant” or “SUN RES” comply with UL 1277 and NEC requirements for outdoor use . Materials like XLPE, UV-stabilized PVC, or fluoropolymers (FEP/PTFE) are commonly used for durability in high-UV environments .

Labeling and Identification

In addition to color coding, tray cables may include printed markings or labels indicating voltage rating, manufacturer, and compliance standards. Proper labeling ensures quick identification, reduces troubleshooting time, and enhances safety in complex installations .
