

What is the job of installing cable tray supports



Overview

Before installation, plan the cable tray route carefully, considering clearance, load capacity, and separation from other utilities. Mark the path using a chalk line or laser level, and identify locations for bends, tees, or elevation changes. Ensure the area is free of obstructions such as pipes or HVAC ducts, and verify compliance with the National Electrical Code (NEC) regarding tray fill ratios and support spacing .

Support Types

- **Wall-Mounted (Cantilever Brackets):** Drill holes at marked support points, insert anchors, and attach cantilever brackets. Ensure brackets are level and capable of supporting the tray load .
- **Ceiling-Suspended (Trapeze or C-Hanger):** Install threaded rods into the structural ceiling, attach a horizontal Unistrut or trapeze channel, and secure the tray. Use nuts and washers to level the support .

- Trapeze or Swing Support: Common for ladder trays, this involves threading hex nuts above the tray, sliding on square washers, and attaching a cross member to support the tray clips. Adjust for horizontal alignment and ensure the cross member is level .

Spacing and Load Considerations

- Support intervals typically range from 1.5 to 3 meters depending on tray type and load .

- Maximum load per hanger is generally 318–340 kg (700–750 lbs) for standard ladder trays .

- Ensure supports are strong enough to prevent sagging and allow for future cable additions.

Installation Best Practices

- Level and Align: Use a level to ensure trays are straight and properly aligned.
- Cutting and Deburring: Measure and cut trays to fit, then deburr edges to prevent cable damage .
- Tray Clips: Install clips inside or outside the tray as needed, allowing for minor horizontal adjustments .
- Grounding and Bonding: Metal trays must be bonded and grounded to maintain electrical safety .
- Cable Management: Use ties or straps to organize cables, leaving slack for expansion or maintenance .

Final Checks

Perform a thorough inspection to verify that all supports are secure, trays are level, spans are within specifications, and no sections are overfilled. Proper documentation and labeling of cables enhance safety and facilitate future maintenance . By following these techniques, cable tray systems can be installed safely, efficiently, and in compliance with electrical codes, ensuring long-term reliability and ease of maintenance .
