Indoor Installation
For indoor overhead distribution boxes, the recommended mounting height is between 4.5 and 5.5 feet (1.4–1.7 meters) from the floor. This height allows easy access for operation, inspection, and maintenance without excessive bending or stretching, and ensures that labels and components are clearly visible. In residential settings, a height of around 1.5 meters is commonly used, which also keeps the box out of reach of children while remaining convenient for adults.

Outdoor Installation

Outdoor distribution boxes should be mounted at least 3 feet (0.9 meters) above the ground to protect against water, dirt, and accidental impacts. In addition, boxes should be placed away from wet areas and have sufficient clearance for ventilation and maintenance. Ground-mounted boxes may also be slightly elevated (2–4 inches) to prevent moisture damage.

Safety and Compliance Considerations

- Ensure the box is installed in a dry, accessible, and ventilated area.
- Follow local electrical codes such as NEC, IEC, or BS 7671 for height and safety requirements .
- Use UL/CE-certified components and include protection devices like breakers, fuses, and surge protectors for each circuit .
- Maintain clear space around the box for inspection and future upgrades.
- Regularly inspect and maintain the box to ensure long-term reliability and safety .
