

What size nuts should be used for cable trays

For use with all channels, M12 channel nuts should always be used for maximum load conditions. The standard finish for all nuts is zinc plated to BS 3382: Part 2, stainless steel (S) and hot dip galvanized (G) finish can be offered upon request. Fastenings: use hexagon head setscrews. They typically pair with roofing bolts to facilitate the assembly of cable trays.
