- 4. **Plastic (PVC)** Plastic trays are cost-effective and corrosion-proof, but they are not suitable for heavy cables or areas with high mechanical stress. They can degrade under UV exposure or extreme temperatures, limiting their long-term performance .

Key Factors in Choosing the Material

- **Load Capacity:** Steel supports heavy cables without sagging. Aluminum and FRP are better for moderate loads.
- **Environmental Conditions:** Stainless steel or FRP for corrosive or outdoor environments; galvanized steel for general indoor/outdoor use.
- **Installation and Maintenance:** Aluminum and FRP are lighter and easier to install, while steel requires more robust mounting but offers long-term durability.
- **Cost vs. Performance:** Steel provides the best balance of strength and longevity, while FRP and aluminum may reduce installation costs in specific scenarios.

Recommendation

For most industrial, commercial, and high-load applications, galvanized or stainless steel cable tray supports are the optimal choice due to their strength, durability, and corrosion resistance. Aluminum or FRP can be considered for lighter loads, weight-sensitive installations, or highly corrosive environments, while plastic is generally reserved for light-duty, non-critical applications .
