- Cool Down the Router: If the device feels hot, turn it off and let it cool completely before restarting .
- Contact Your ISP: If the red light persists after these steps, the issue may be with the ISP's network or the ONT, requiring professional assistance .

Additional Tips

- Handle fiber optic cables carefully; they are fragile and can be easily damaged.
- Avoid moving the router frequently or bending the fiber cable sharply.
- Keep the router in a well-ventilated area to prevent overheating. Following these steps usually resolves a red LOS light and restores your internet connection. If the problem continues, your ISP may need to replace the fiber line or the ONT.
