A sub-distribution box (SDB) is a secondary panel connected to the main distribution board (MDB) to supply power to specific areas or circuits within a building, such as a garage, basement, or additional rooms. The SDB allows for localized control, easier troubleshooting, and expansion of circuits without overloading the main panel.

Step-by-Step Wiring Process

- Turn Off Main Power Always switch off the main breaker at the MDB to prevent electrical shock before starting any wiring.
- Select Feeder Cable Choose a cable rated for the total load of the sub panel. The feeder typically includes live (phase), neutral, and ground conductors. The wire size depends on the amperage of the sub panel and the distance from the main panel.
- Install the Sub Panel Mount the SDB securely at an accessible location. Ensure it has its own main breaker to act as a disconnecting device.

- Connect Feeder to Main Panel
 - Identify a breaker in the MDB to supply the sub panel.
 - Connect the live wires from the feeder to this breaker.
 - Run the neutral wire to the neutral bus bar in the MDB.
 - Connect the ground wire to the ground bus bar in the MDB .
 - Connect Feeder to Sub Panel
 - Attach the live wires to the main breaker in the SDB.
 - Connect the neutral wire to the neutral bus bar and the ground wire to the ground bus bar.
 - Do not bond neutral and ground in the sub panel; they must remain separate to prevent ground loops and ensure safety .
 - Install Branch Circuit Breakers Place breakers in the SDB for each circuit it will supply. Connect each circuit's live, neutral, and ground wires to the corresponding terminals .
 - Label Circuits Clearly label each breaker in the SDB to indicate the area or appliance it controls. This simplifies maintenance and troubleshooting .
 - Test Connections Use a multimeter to verify proper voltage, continuity, and absence of short circuits before turning on the main power .
- Safety and Compliance
- Ensure all wiring complies with local electrical codes.
 - Use properly rated breakers and cables for the load.
 - Keep neutral and ground separate in the sub panel.
 - Consider consulting a licensed electrician if unsure about load calculations or code requirements . By following these steps, you can safely and efficiently connect a sub-distribution box to a main distribution board, providing reliable power distribution and localized control for your building.
